## Hotham Primary School National Results 2019



Our results demonstrate that pupils leaving Hotham consistently outperform others nationally. We are very proud of the hard work and achievement of our pupils and staff.

### **Key Stage 2 Results**

Pupils in Year 6 take SATS tests. These tests are used to ascertain whether children are working at the 'Expected Standard' or are working above this, at 'Greater Depth'. They also give an average score, comparing the results to the national average score of 100. The progress score indicates the progress our children have made compared to those nationally.

### **Key Stage 1 Results**

Pupils in Year 2 take SATS tests which are used to inform teacher assessments. Teachers decide whether children are working at the 'Expected Standard' or are working above this, at 'Greater Depth'.
